


The decision will be made early in the morning and published on our <u>website</u> and broadcasted on local radio stations BBC Oxford VHF/FM 95.2 and Heart (Thames Valley) VHF/FM 102.6 and 97.4/102.9/103.4 or Jack FM VHF/FM 106.8 and its sister station 107.9.
